To consider and approve the engagement of Dr. Jyothi Pramod, Assistant Medical Officer (Maternal & Child care) on contract in Cantonment Hospital, St. Thomas Mount.

Dr. Jyothi Pramod has been engaged as Assistant Medical Officer (Maternal & Childcare) on contract basis in Cantonment Board Hospital, St. Thomas Mount at the honorarium of Rs. 1,500/- per visit. She had joined the duty on 25.11.2013. As per CBR No. 3 dated 25.04.2016, her honorarium has been increased from Rs. 1,000/- to Rs. 1,500/- per visit. Further, the Board has increased her honorarium of Rs. 1,500/- for normal visit and Rs. 2,500/-per emergency visit be paid, whenever she attends the labour during the odd hours. Also vide CBR No. 28

8. DETERMINATION OF LEASE IN GLRSY NO.388/258, SITUATED OUTSIDE CIVIL/BAZAAR AREA OF ST.THOMAS MOUNT CUM PALLAVARAM CANTONMENT.

The Defence Estates Officer, Madras Circle, vide letter No.N/228/70/MC dated 11-10-2018 has intimated that the defence land measuring 0.85 Acre comprising GLRS No.388/258 of St.Thomas Mount cum Pallavaram Cantonment was originally granted on lease in schedule VIII of CLA rules 1937 for a term of 30 years renewable at option of lessee up to 90 years with effect from 06-07-1942 for dwelling house.

The said lease land in GLRS No.388/258 is situated Outside Civil/Bazaar area of St.Thomas Mount cum Pallavaram Cantonment and placed under management of the Defence Estates Officer, Madras Circle.

The lease for the 01st term expired on 05.02.1972. The lease could not be renewed for the 02nd term of 30 years with effect from 06.07.1972 as the lessees deceased and their legal heirs did not produce any legal documents. Hence, the Defence Estates officer, Madras Circle has initiated proposal for determination of the lease in GLRS No.388/258, measuring 0.85 Acre.

In this connection, the Defence Estates Officer, Madras Circle has intend to ascertain that, after determination, the said lease site measuring 0.85 acre in GLRS NO.388/258 of St.Thomas Mount cum Pallavaram Cantonment can be put use by the LMA for Army use or by the Cantonment Board for Municipal purpose.

The relevant documents are placed on the table. The Board may decide accordingly.

The Defence Estates Officer, Madras Circle, vide letter No.N/229/II/97/MC, dated 11-10-2018 has intimated that the defence land measuring 2.50 Acres comprising GLRSY No.388/723 of St.Thomas Mount cum Pallavaram, Cantonment was originally granted on lease in schedule VIII of CLA rules 1937 for a term of 30 years renewable at option of lessee up to 90 years with effect from 06-07-1942 for dwelling house.

The said lease land in GLRSY No.388/723 is situated Outside Civil/Bazaar Area of St.Thomas Mount cum Pallavaram Cantonment and placed under management of the Defence Estates Officer, Madras Circle.

The lease for the 01st term expired on 05.07.1972 and 02nd term of the lease for 30 years with effect from 06.07.1972 has been renewed The 02nd term of lease has expired on 05.07.2002.

As the lessees deceased and their legal heirs did not produce any legal documents due to family dispute among them the lease could not be renewed for

the 03rd and last term of 30years due from 06-07-2002. Hence, the Defence Estates Officer, Madras Circle has initiated proposal for determination of the lease in GLRSY No.388/723, measuring 2.50 Acres.

In this connection, the Defence Estates Officer, Madras circle has intend to ascertain that after determination, the said lease site measuring 2.50 Acres in GLRSY No.388/723 of St.Thomas Mount cum Pallavaram can be put to use by the LMA for Military purpose or by the Cantonment Board for Municipal purpose.

The relevant documents are placed on the table. The Board may decide accordingly.

It is informed that the existing Water Tanker Vehicle No. TN 22 AW 6370 (12,000 litres capacity) life time period has expired, since the vehicle was purchased in the year 2004. Now the Water Tanker is very unconditional to operate and run in the Cantonment roads at St.Thomas Mount cum Pallavaram.

The New Vehicle will be purchased during the financial year 2019-2020 and the necessary budget provisions will be done for the same.

Mean while Elected members have asked to arrange one temporary vehicle on Hire basis for the use of direct water supply to areas in ward No's 4,5,6 & 7. The average of 5 trips are required per week.
